All entries will be displayed at Denver Zoo's Prairie Dog Day event on Sunday, January 31, from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 3 p.m. **Every student who enters the art contest will receive (1) free children's admission for Prairie Dog Day, Sunday January 31, at Denver Zoo. Additionally, every art piece that is entered into Denver Zoo's Prairie Dog Art Contest will be considered for Denver Zoo's 2011 Prairie Dog Calendar.** Twelve art pieces will be chosen to create Denver Zoo's first edition of the Prairie Dog Calendar.

The contest is divided in to three age groups: Preschool-K, 1st -3rd grade, 4th-6th grade.

Artwork Requirements: Drawing or painting showcasing the prairie ecosystem, including prairie dogs and other prairie species
Watercolor, oil, pastels, colored pencils or computer generated
No smaller than 8-1/2" x 11" and no larger than 18" x 24"
