Scholarships are awarded based on need. Maximum scholarship amount awarded will not exceed 90% for a single camp or \$500 per family for an entire year. Applications must be submitted at least two weeks before you need to be registered. Example: to be registered by Friday, November 17, an application must be submitted by Friday, November 3.	If your scholarship is forfeited at any point, you will not be able to apply again. Scholarship submissions will close when all scholarship funding has been awarded.	If your camper will take prescription or over-the-counter medication during camp (including Epi-Pens and Inhalers), the Medication Administration Permission Form is REQUIRED two weeks prior to their start date.
We accept campers Pre-K to 8 th grade, and they must be registered for the grade level they will be entering in Fall 2020. Pre-K campers must be at least 4 years old. Service and Accommodation Fees

**Scholarship funds DO NOT cover Early and/or Late Care, or Service and Accommodation Fees.

Early Care *pre-registration required (Drop-off 7:30 AM – 8:45 AM)	\$50 per child per week	
Late Care *pre-registration required (Pick-up 4:15 PM – 5:00 PM)	\$50 per child per week	
Late Arrival/Early Pick-Up **With advance notice, campers may be dropped-off or picked-up between 12:00 PM – 1:00 PM at no charge.	\$5 per child per instance	
Camper not picked up by 5:00 PM	\$10 per child for every 15 minutes late	
Camp Transfer or Cancellation	\$50 per child per camp	

^{*}Cancellations and transfers must be requested via e-mail to guestcare@denverzoo.org at least 15 business days before the start of your camp date. Within 14 business days, all sales are final.
