



Outreach Program Agreement

Safety Procedures and Requirements for COVID-19.

For the health and safety of staff, participants, and animals, Denver Zoo and the Program Site agree to the following standards and expectations:

- Site will inform Denver Zoo of site-specific procedures.
- Site will advise participants to stay home if feeling sick.
- Masks are required for Zoo staff and all adults at site; masks recommended for participant age 3+.
- 6 feet minimum required between Zoo staff/animal ambassadors and participants.
- Group size may not exceed 25 people; multiple sequential programs may be required to stay within limits.
- Programs should be conducted outside. If site does not have an adequate outdoor location, ideally with full to partial shade, it will coordinate with Denver Zoo to hold the program in a large indoor space such as a gym or cafeteria.
- Participants may not touch animals or biofacts; touching of other props/materials is with strict guidance from Zoo staff.
- Hand sanitizing before and after program is required when touching of props/materials is permitted. Zoo staff will disinfect props/materials before and after each program.

Additionally, per Denver Zoo protocols, all Denver Zoo employees are required to:

- complete daily temperature screenings before beginning work,
- wear a mask while performing work at Denver Zoo and in the community,
- be trained and practice appropriate sanitizing procedures,
- follow social distancing protocols.

Zoo staff may modify program activities to meet safety guidelines, and reserves the right to cancel the program and leave the site at any time, should safety guidelines not be met.
