Welcome to your overnight adventure at Denver Zoo! Please look over the following important information to ensure that you are ready for your evening at the Zoo.

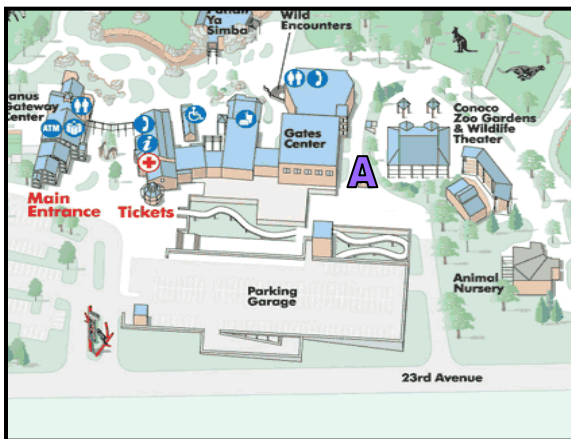
Check-In: 5pm-6pm

Check-Out: 9:30am

PACKING LIST

- 1, 2, or 4 person pop up tent. No staked tents allowed. Please limit tent size to accommodate the number of people in your group as space is limited to allow for proper social distancing.
- Sleeping bag, pad, pillow. Limited availability to electricity for inflating air mattresses (battery operated pumps welcome). Ground will be hard so we recommend some type of pad, air mattress, or cot to sleep on.
- Weather appropriate clothing; pajamas; personal care items.
- 1-2 masks per person.
- Lanterns and/or flashlights (allowed at campsite only).
- Water bottles
- Portable charger or power bank for cell phones as availability to electricity is limited.
- Wagon for transporting gear from cars to campsite. Wagons may be rented for additional cost at Zoo.

Deadlines and Participant Policies: Program registration closes 4 days before program date. Additional participants may be added up until this point based on ticket availability. See “cancelations and refunds for further details.



PARKING

Park on Level 2, 3, or 4 of the parking garage. Once parked, carry gear to the Special Programs Entrance (located at level 2 up the ramp from the elevators - marked “A” on the map). A staff member will be present at the gate for check in from 5-6pm. **Participants will not be admitted in the zoo before check-in time.**

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- **What to Expect**

Evenings will include self-guided Zoo exploration, attractions, up-close animal looks, night vision stations, and campfires with S'mores. Mornings will include hot breakfast and additional up-close animal looks! After morning check-out, registered participants are welcome to continue enjoying Denver Zoo on their own. Please note that you must return all your gear to your vehicles in the morning before breakfast. We do not have a place to store gear.

- **Chaperones**

Adult chaperones **are required**. A portion of this overnight will include self-guided exploration without zoo staff. Chaperones must supervise children at all times. A minimum of **one adult chaperone must be present in each tent**. Plan for a minimum of **1 chaperone per every 3-5 children**.

- **Security/Safety**

The Denver Zoo has 24-hour security officers that are trained in first aid and CPR. See Denver Zoo website for most current COVID-19 safety policies and procedures.

- **Cancellations or Refunds**

This is a nonrefundable program. We encourage you to find age-appropriate substitutes if one or more of your participants cannot attend. Your overnight adventure will take place in any type of weather. **Planned outdoor activities will occur, "rain, snow, or shine", so please bring appropriate clothing and gear**. If the zoo must cancel a program due to weather, transfers or full refunds will be issued.

- **Late Arrivals/Early Departures**

Due to the nature of this program and impact on staffing, late arrivals and early departures are difficult to accommodate. Please try to arrive on time and utilize the check-in window of 5-6pm. Early departures for the morning are only allowed after 7:30am. There are no exceptions to these windows.
