<p>Be sure to read our Policies & Procedures. We accept campers Kindergarten – 8th Grade, they must be registered for the grade level they are currently in.</p> <p>Campers must have turned 5 years old by October 15, 2022.</p>	<p>What to bring:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Backpack Lunch + 2 Snacks Water Bottle Weather appropriate clothing and footwear. <p><i>Please leave toys, technology, or materials of sentimental or financial value at home.</i></p>	<p>If an adult decides to stay at the zoo, we ask that they explore away from their child/children. Adults must have a timed-entry ticket and enter at the main entrance.</p>	<p>Photo ID is REQUIRED every day to pick up a child from camp.</p> <p><i>Campers are only released to adults listed as parents/guardians or authorized pick-ups. Be sure the list is up-to-date HERE.</i></p>
<p>If your camper will take prescription or over-the-counter medication during camp (including Epi-Pens and inhalers), the Medication Authorization Form is REQUIRED and must be received two weeks prior to their camp date. <i>Medication must be in the original container with original prescription label.</i></p>	<p>Campers must bring a packed lunch, as well as a morning and afternoon snack, each day. <i>Apple sauce is available for campers without a snack. Nut-free is encouraged. Heating and refrigeration are not available.</i></p>	<p>Camp runs in rain, snow or shine. Make sure your camper is dressed for the weather.</p>	<p>All lost items will be taken to the Zoo's Lost and Found at the Main Entrance in Guest Services.</p>
<p>We provide Rocky Mountain Sunscreen: SPF 30, oxybenzone free, water resistant, and fragrance free. <i>You are welcome to pack an alternative; please label with first and last name.</i></p>	<p>Drop-off concludes at 9:00 AM. Arrivals after 9:00 AM must go to the Welcome Center at the Zoo's main entrance and a "Late Arrival" accommodation fee of \$5 will be collected for each instance per child.</p>	<p>In the rare event that severe weather (including extreme cold temperatures) is expected to impact camp, Denver Zoo will contact the registering parent/guardian via email regarding delayed starts, early closures, and/or full day closures.</p>	<p>Pick-up concludes, at 4:15 PM. After 4:15 PM, an accommodation fee of \$10 for every 15 min will be collected for each child.</p>
<p>In addition to hand washing, we provide 70-80% alcohol-based hand sanitizer. <i>You are welcome to pack an alternative; please label with first and last name.</i></p>	<p>Late drop-offs need to be pre-arranged with Camp Administrators. Parking and Drop-off/Pick-up

Please park in the parking garage, if space is available.

Camp drop-off and pick-up occurs at the Special Programs Entrance (marked "★" on the map shown). This entrance is located directly up the steps from the elevators on the second level (Macaw Level) of the parking garage (orange arrow on the map).

Drop-Off Instructions:

1. Drop your camper off between 8:45 - 9:00 AM.
2. Parents/guardians must screen children for illness/symptoms daily, prior to arriving at camp. **Dropping-off a child at camp affirms they are healthy and free of any signs, symptoms, or exposure of illnesses to the best of your knowledge:**

Pick-up Instructions:

1. Pick your camper up between 4:00 - 4:15 PM.
1. **Photo ID is REQUIRED** every day to pick up a child from camp.



Safety/Supervision

Denver Zoo Security and Camp Staff are certified in First Aid and CPR. Our camp has a 1:10 staff to camper ratio. All staff and adult volunteers have undergone extensive background checks.

Accommodations for Special Needs

If your child has any special needs we should be aware of, please contact us. We are more than happy to discuss all options available. If your child needs to attend camp with his/her full-time care provider, special arrangements can be made, but **must be scheduled in advance** for security purposes. After undergoing a background check, the adult caregiver may attend at no charge, subject to health and safety checks.

Service and Accommodation Fees

Late Arrival/Early Pick-Up **Must be scheduled in advance	\$5 per child per instance
Camper not picked up by 4:15 PM	\$10 per child for every 15 minutes late
Camp Cancellation	\$15 per child per camp. Within 7 business days, all sales are final
