<p>APPLY HERE</p> <p><u>DO NOT</u> purchase a camp before applying.</p> <p>Scholarships are awarded based on need. Maximum scholarship awarded will not exceed 90% for a single camp .</p> <p>Scholarship funds are available for a maximum of 3 days of each fall, winter, and spring camp.</p>	<p>It can take 1-2 weeks to process your scholarship request. If your request is accepted, you will receive an e-mail confirming your award.</p> <p>You will have 48 hours after receiving your award letter to pay your balance. Make sure you are able to pay any rewarded scholarship amounts before applying. After 48 hours, your scholarship will be forfeited and your spot(s) will be released.</p>	<p>Download and read the Safari Camp Important Information PDF, as well as Safari Camp Policies and Procedures located on the camp webpage to ensure you are prepared for camp.</p> <p>Photo ID will be required every day to pick up a child from camp.</p>
<p>Scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis. Scholarships cannot be guaranteed.</p> <p>Scholarship funds do not cover Service and accommodation fees or Late Care.</p> <p>Incomplete applications will not be considered.</p>	<p>After making your payment and successfully reserving your spot(s), you will be sent an email with instructions to complete Step 2 of your registration - filling out required information and waivers.</p> <p>Campers cannot attend Summer Safari until Step 2 of registration is complete.</p>	<p>Campers need to bring the following to camp each day:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Lunch + 2 snacks: Nut-free is encouraged. Heating and refrigeration are not available. • Backpack • Water bottle • Weather appropriate clothing and footwear
<p>Scholarship submissions will close when all scholarship funding has been awarded or all spots are reserved.</p>	<p>If your scholarship is forfeited at any point, you are not eligible to apply again.</p>	<p>If your camper will take prescription or over-the-counter medication during camp (<i>including Epi-Pens and Inhalers</i>), the Medication Administration Permission Form is REQUIRED three weeks prior to their start date.</p>
<p>Fall, Winter, and Spring Safari Camps are generally available for grades K-5. Campers must be registered for the grade level they are currently in.</p> <p>Campers must have turned 5 years old by October 1 the year prior.</p>	<p>See Service and Accommodation Fees below. 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Service and Accommodation Fees: *Scholarship funds DO NOT cover Service and Accommodation Fees.*

Cancellation Policy	All sales are final, unless the Zoo must cancel the program.
Late Arrival/Early Pickup	With advance notice, children may be dropped off or picked up during lunchtime (12:00–1:00 p.m.) at no charge, as campers are always in a pre-defined area during the lunch hour. At other times of the day, campers may be anywhere within the 80-acre Zoo property (or on a field trip), making late arrivals and early departures complicated, resulting in an \$5 accommodation fee.
Late Pickup	It is mandatory that campers not registered for Late Care are picked up by 4:15 p.m. Parents/guardians are asked to notify Camp Staff if they are running late. After 4:15 p.m., parents/guardians, emergency contacts, and authorized pick-ups will be notified that the child needs to be picked up as soon as possible and an accommodation fee of \$10 will be charged every 15 minutes after 4:15 p.m. until they are picked up.
Transfer Policy	All sales are final. Transfer will not be considered outside of the noted policies in which a parent/caregiver registered children for the wrong age/grade group, registered children who are not their own and/or registered a child for multiple camps with the same title. These circumstances will result in a dropped registration without refund or, in the rare situation where a transfer is available to rectify the neglected policy, a minimum administrative fee of \$50 per transferred camp. Note, transfers are not guaranteed and rarely available
